<u>POSITION</u>	Campaign Worker Temporary Full-time and Part-time
<u>RESPONSIBILITIES</u>	Work to execute the AFT-Oregon Political Education and Mobilization Plan for the 2014 Election. Primary duties include: member-to-member union organizing, making phone calls to likely voters to identify their support, and walking door-to-door contacting union households/voters. May include other assigned duties and Get-Out-The-Vote (GOTV) activities. Reports to Political Action Organizer.
<u>QUALIFICATIONS</u>	General knowledge of the political process or union/community organizing preferred, including experience working on political, community or union campaigns. Strong communication and interpersonal skills are a must. Duties include phone calling to contact lists for extended hours at a time; walking outdoors for several hours at a time in all weather conditions; data entry. Computer literate. Additional skills include ability to work cooperatively with other workers and volunteers, ability to maintain a flexible schedule depending upon the needs of the job. Position includes evening and weekend work.
<u>AVAILABILITY</u>	Full-time and part-time positions available. Ability to work flexible schedule, including evenings and weekends, required. Full-time applicant must be available to work forty hours per week, including evenings and weekends. Schedules and hours will vary depending on assignments and program objectives. For example, a sample Full-Time assignment schedule might include Monday-Thursday, Noon to 8 p.m., and Saturday and Sunday, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.; a sample .5 FTE assignment schedule might include Monday-Thursday, 5 p.m. to 9 p.m., and Saturday or Sunday, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
<u>LOCATION</u>	Portland, Oregon. Alternate locations may be used on occasion.
<u>DURATION</u>	Approximately 7 weeks beginning Monday September 15, 2014. Program ends Wednesday, November 5 th , 2014.
<u>COMPENSATION</u>	Salary is \$600 per week full time; prorated portion for less than full-time based on the FTE.
