As President of AFT from 1974 to 1997, Albert Shanker worked to build a powerful union including not only teachers, but paraprofessionals, public employees and healthcare professionals. During his presidency, AFT tripled its membership and grew to more than 900,000 members in 1997.

- Must be a child or grandchild of an AFT-Oregon member in good standing.
- Must be currently enrolled in an accredited higher education, trade or technical program and planning to continue in the next academic year.
- Must submit a completed application before the deadline.

- Writing Assignment Complete the essay assignment as directed and don't forget the certification at the end of the essay.
- Reference You must provide at least two. They should be an adult who knows you well, such as teachers or community leaders, and can attest to your outstanding qualities. Provide your references with an official reference sheet. Completed references can be sent with the application or separately, but must be received by the deadline.
- Transcripts Include a copy of your most recent transcript from your current college or education program. If you are a freshman please include your final high school transcript.
